Thinking Creatively: Creating Titles

Creating new titles for works of art is a fun way to think creatively and make inferences—ideas based on reasoning and evidence—about what you see.

Select a work of art in the museum's galleries or from the <u>collection</u> page of the museum's website that catches your attention. Try to not look at the title the artist created.

Create a new title for this work.

This could be a single word or a short phrase describing something you observe or an idea you have about the artwork. Your title could also connect to moods, feelings, or a story that is suggested.

What is your new title?

Why did you choose this title? Write or draw your response. Compare your title to the actual title of the work. What do you notice?
